Pink Out Picnic

Host a pink out picnic in your backyard! Picnic fundraisers are a great idea to generate proceeds while encouraging outdoor fun. Planning a pink out picnic fundraiser means choosing creative announcements, determining an entrance fee, preparing food, finding volunteers, and lining up a raffle to bring in even more funds for The Breast Cancer Charities of America.

Helpful Pink Out Picnic Tips!

- ✿ Select a large, spacious area in your backyard, and covered areas are nice to have just in case it rains.
- ✿ Make announcements, include time, date, location, and cost. Be creative with these and let your guests know what the cause is for, breast cancer.
- ✿ Decide on how your group will collect donations. A nice idea would be to have an entrance fee; \$5 per person and collect donations from a raffle. Another way to collect additional funds is to have a pink bucket or jar to have people give donations.
- ✿ Get volunteers, ask your friends, neighbors, and family to help with decorations, picnic blankets, food, refreshments, and items for the raffle. Even contact local business for donations for the picnic basket raffle. Good items to ask for the basket are picnic blankets, cloth napkins, picnic utensils and wine glasses. If local businesses do decide to donate, don't forget to give merchants credit in your announcements and at the raffle table.
- ✿ Make a menu of what you would like to serve at your picnic, think picnic foods: sandwiches, salads, chips, desserts, and drinks. After you make your menu, ask each volunteer to prepare the selected food. Or another option is to consider organizing a potluck. Make a sign-up sheet listing common picnic foods like sandwiches, salads, chips, drinks, and desserts.
- ✿ Be sure to have a variety of activities, a picnic is not complete without fun activities. Good activities to play at a picnic are tug of war, hot potato, or balloon toss.
- ✿ Have fun and enjoy the picnic and picnic activities and be sure to write thank you notes to all the participants.
